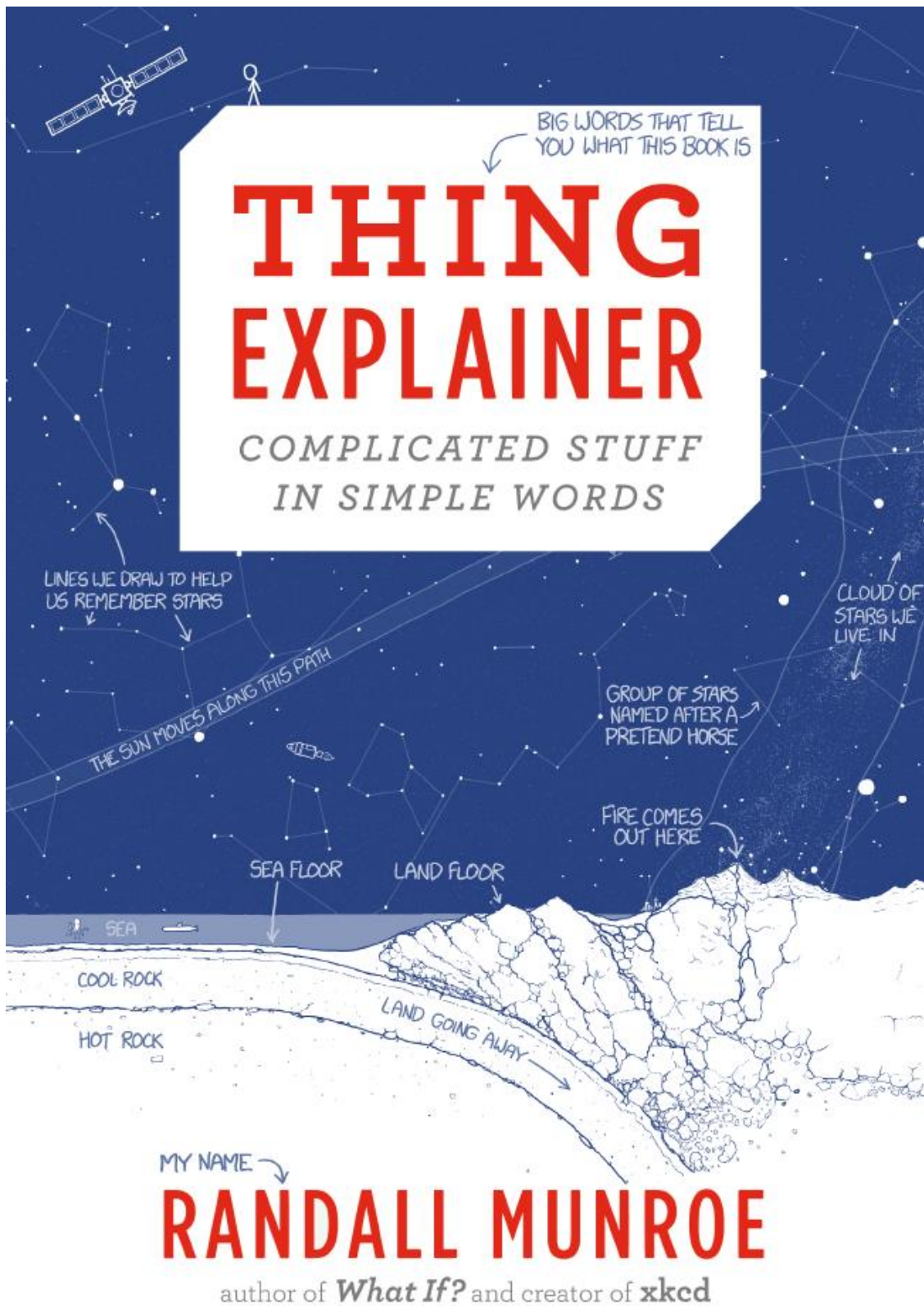


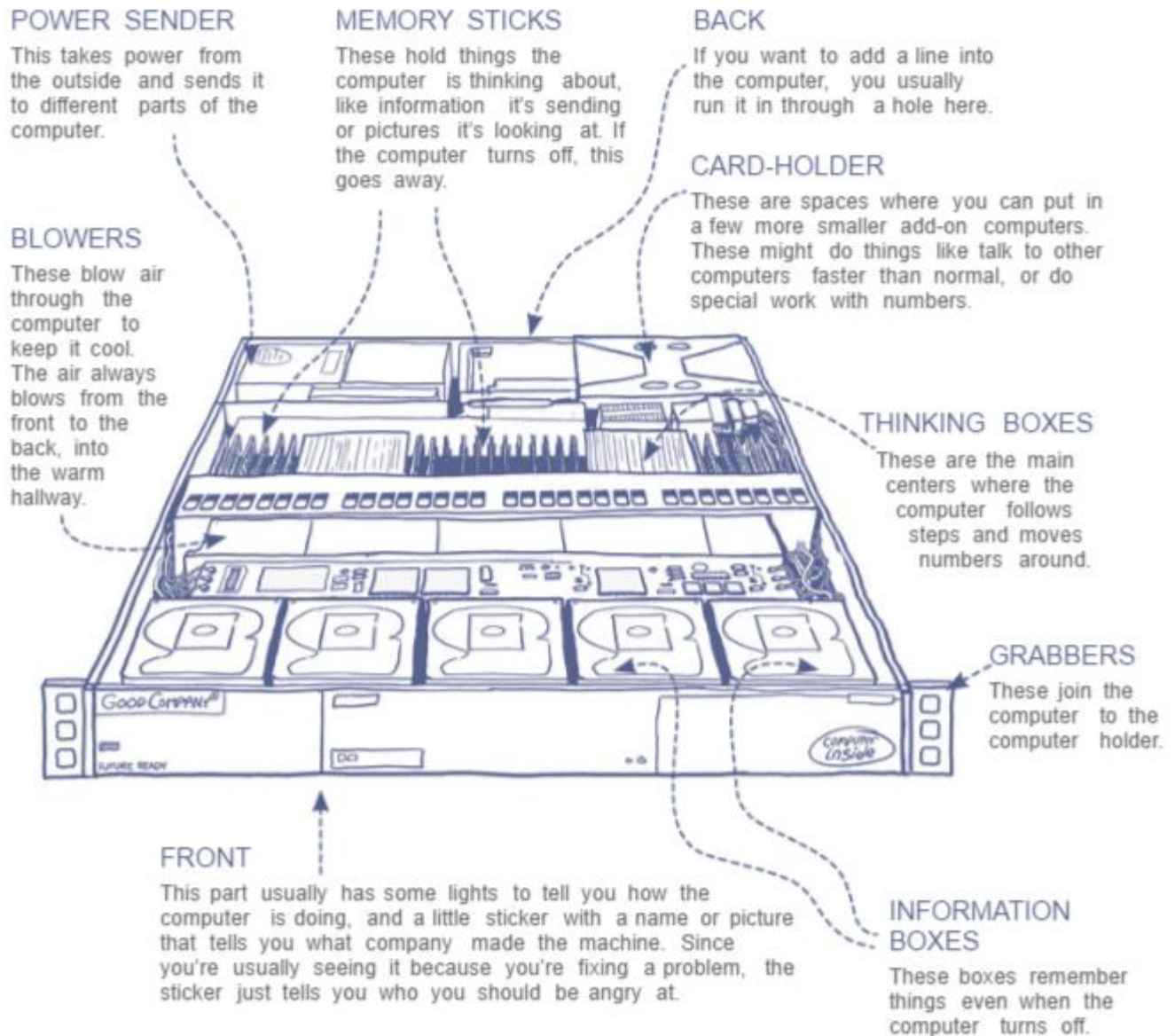

These diagrams are from a book where the author tried to only use the 1000 most common words to explain complex things.

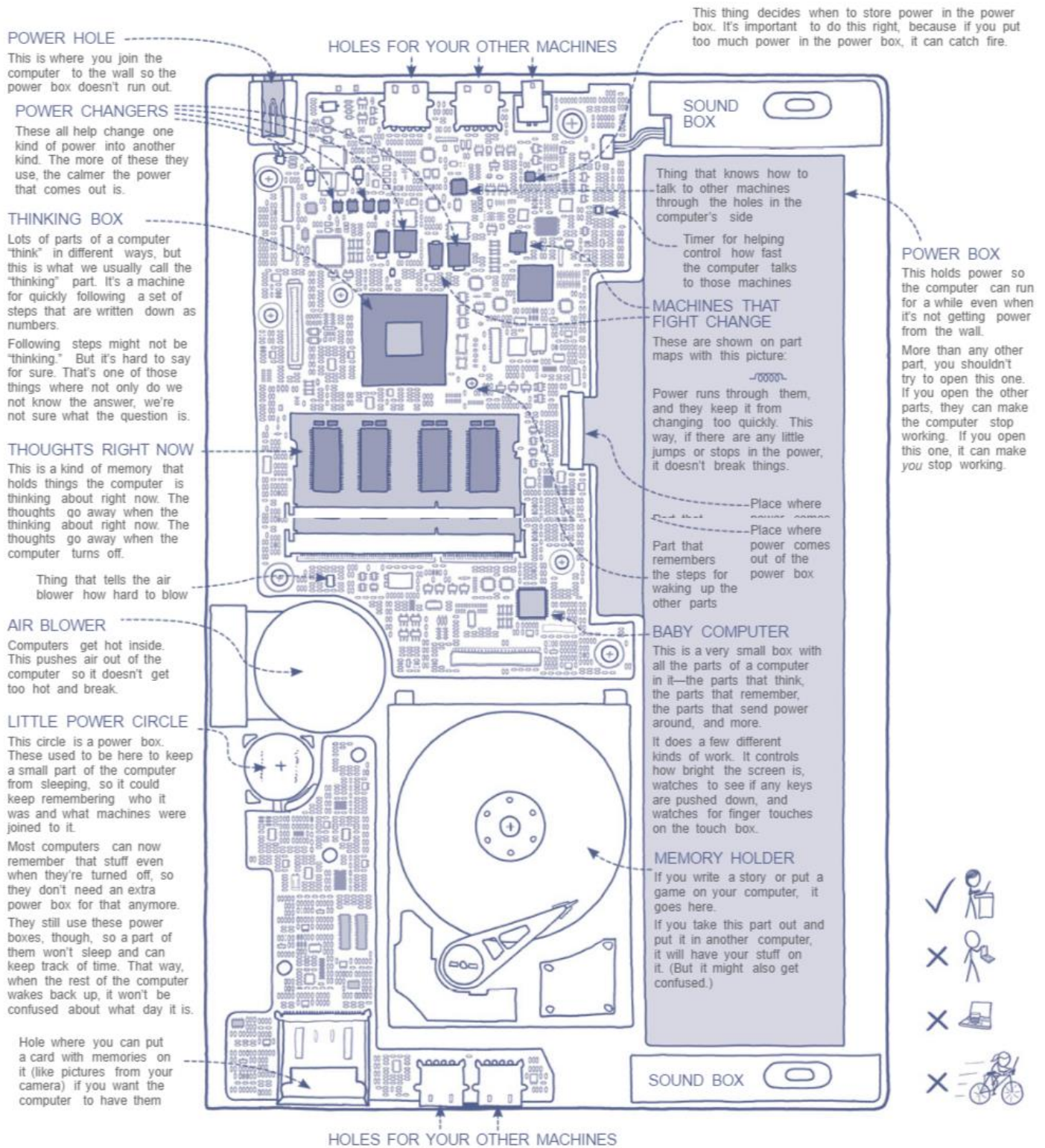
Read the descriptions and identify the hardware found in the picture.
