

# Installing Java

When you are finished installing Java, click on the Assignment folder and type in “I’m Done” in the question box.



If you have a PC, your best choice is **Ready to Program**.

- Download the file.
- Unzip it. If you have never done that before, this is how to unzip a folder of pictures, but you need to do the same sort of thing to unzip your folder:

- Click on the file Setup.exe and choose to install.



If you have a Mac, your best choice is **Eclipse Oxygen**.

This can also be installed on a PC, if Ready to Program doesn't work.

- FIRST, download and install JDK (Java Development Kit)

- SECOND, download and install Eclipse Oxygen
  - <https://www.eclipse.org/downloads/packages/release/oxygen/3>



If you have a Chromebook, use repl.it as a temporary solution: <https://repl.it/languages/java10>

- Do not log on. Do not sign up.
- Simply type in your code and run it.
- To save, copy and paste your code to a Google Doc.
